To Owners Who Keep More Than Two Dogs on Their Property

Pursuant to Clause 10 (Limitation on number of dogs) of Council's Dog Control Bylaw "No more than 2 dogs of registrable age (whether or not such dogs are registered) may be kept on any premises situated in the urban, industrial, or rural settlement resource areas as defined by the Clutha District Plan unless the owner or occupier is the holder of a licence to keep more than two dogs".

Every application for a licence shall be made in writing to Council and be accompanied by the appropriate fee, and:

- a. shall be subject to such conditions as Council sees fit to impose, and
- b. shall have effect only in relation to the premises described on the licence, and
- c. shall not be transferable to any other premises or person.

The information provided on this form will be kept by Clutha District Council but may only be used for lawful official purposes and will not generally be available to the public. However, section 35 of the Dog Control Act 1996 allows the name and address of the owner of any specified dog to be made available to any person who has made a written application for that information. The territorial authority must be satisfied of the identity of that applicant and the information is required for one of a limited number of specified purposes, such as returning a lost dog to its owner or seeking compensation for damage.

CONDITIONS RELATING TO THE ISSUE OF A LICENCE

The keeping of more than two dogs by the occupier of any property is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The number of dogs on the premises shall NOT exceed the number permitted as indicated on the licence.
- 2. All dogs kept on the premises must be housed in such a manner as not to cause nuisance to neighbours.
- 3. Kennels, runs and other areas on the property used by the dogs must be kept clean and free from nuisance conditions.
- 4. All requirements of the Dog Control Act 1996 and the Clutha District Dog Control Bylaw must be met.
- 5. The licence specifically precludes housing or breeding of dogs as a commercial enterprise unless Resource Consent has been granted under the Clutha District Plan.
- 6. All deaths, sales or transfers of dogs, (including pups born on the premises) are to be notified to Council within 14 days.
- 7. Prior application shall be made to Council before any changes are undertaken that affect the terms and conditions under which the licence is issued.
- 8. No change of dog breed/s is permitted without prior Council approval.
- 9. A licence may be subject to such terms, conditions and restrictions as Council may from time to time consider necessary to impose,
- 10. A licence may be revoked if there is any breach of its terms and conditions.
- 11. Licences are not transferable between occupiers or between premises.
