Public Holiday	Date	Collection information
New Years Day	Wednesday, 1 January	No wheelie bin collection on Wednesday, 1 January. Collection will be carried out Thursday, 2 January.
Waitangi Day	Thursday, 6 February	Collection as usual.
Otago Anniversary	Monday, 24 March	Collection as usual.
Good Friday	Friday, 18 April	No wheelie bin collection on Friday, 18 April. Collection will be carried out Saturday, 19 April.
Easter Monday	Monday, 21 April	Collection as usual.
Anzac Day	Friday, 25 April	*Wheelie bin collection starts at 12pm.
King's Birthday	Monday, 2 June	Collection as usual.

WHAT TO PUT IN YOUR RUBBISH WHEELIE BIN (RED/GREEN LID):

- General (non-recyclable) waste, for example:
- Glass
- Food waste
- Cold, bagged ashes
- Nappies
- Plastic bags and plastic cling film
- Green/garden waste
- Polystyrene



WHAT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING WHEELIE BIN (YELLOW LID):

- Clean plastic bottles, trays and containers numbered 1, 2 and 5.
- Clean paper and cardboard.
- Clean aluminium/steel cans and tins.

If it doesn't come from the bathroom, laundry or kitchen, leave it out.

Public Holiday	Date	Collection information
Christmas Day	Thursday, 25 December	No wheelie bin collection on Thursday, 25 December. Collection will be carried out Friday, 26 December

Using the kerbside service

- The bin belongs at the property, please do not remove for any reason.
- Have your bin out by 7am on your collection day.
- Bring your bin in from the kerb on the same day as collection.
- Place facing the kerb (handles away from the street).
- Place 1m clear of cars, power poles and other bins.
- Maximum weight 30kg.
- The lid must be fully closed.
- No liquids.
- Ash must be bagged and cold.
- Recycling must be loose—do not bag.
- Each bin is collected fortnightly, on alternate weeks.

Kerbside collection days

Monday Balclutha (South of river, excluding Charlotte Street) Kaka Point, Owaka.

Tuesday Balclutha (North of river, including Charlotte Street) Benhar, Stirling, Inch Clutha.

Wednesday Tapanui, Kelso, Waipahi, Clinton, Heriot.

Thursday Kaitangata, Waiholo, Milton (west of Union Street, north of Abercrombie Street and including Johnston Street).

Friday Remainder of Milton, Tokoiti, Lawrence, Waitahuna.
