#### 1 Background

On 12 September 2024 Council agreed to a special consultation process under the Local Government Act 2002 together with the consultation document in relation to options concerning the Bruce Community Facility.

The consultation was subsequently undertaken, commencing on 23 September 2024 and concluding at 5pm on 23 October 2024.

## 4 Consultation Options and Preliminary Results of Submission (Note 1)

Submissions/feedback was sought on two options in relation to the Bruce Community Facility.

The options and results were as follows:

Option 2: Do not build a new library and pool facility.	320 (50.16%)
